- Social media is not to be used to air any grievances about players, coaches, managers, committee or referees and will not be tolerated.
- Any parent/ guardian and/or spectator who feels the necessity to:
 - Persistently or wilfully question or challenge the rulings of the referees.
 - Berate or abuse referees
 - Berate or abuse players
 - Berate or abuse other parents or spectators
 - Display conduct which is inappropriate in a sporting environment
 - WILL be asked to cease their behaviour or be asked to leave the venue immediately by P&DBA staff.
- Inappropriate language either verbal, text or social media will not be tolerated.
- Any parent/guardian and/or spectator in breach of the code of conduct may receive a written warning from the club and or P&DBA.
- Continued breaches of conduct will result in their child being ineligible to play with Glenmore Park Basketball Club.
